

Levi's Page: Plan Your Trip to Baffin Island

An Internet Exploration Activity

Use an Internet *travel service* to plan a one-week trip to Iqaluit, Nunavut, Canada. Imagine that your trip begins tomorrow.

1. In what city (-ies) does your flight stop?
2. What is the price of the least expensive flight you could select? What is the highest price?
3. At what time does your flight leave? Arrive? What is the duration of your travel?
4. Where will you stay while there?
5. When does your return flight leave? Arrive in San Antonio? What is the duration of your travel?

Use an Internet *weather advisor* to discover what the weather will be like in Iqaluit tomorrow. Report the weather below:

What kind of clothing will you pack?

1. Will it be dark or daylight when you arrive?
2. Will it be dark or daylight when you leave?

Use an *Internet currency converter* to discover what kind of money is used in Canada.

1. What is Canadian currency called?
2. What is the exchange rate?

What kind of citizenship documentation (passport? visa? other?) will you use in order to enter the country?

Use a *Canada travel site* to discover what to see and do on your trip. Tell about the capital, Iqaluit, and the territory of Nunavut and its culture and people. Name three things you would like to do or see.
